

SHOW RULES

1. In Members' classes, all exhibits should be grown by the Exhibitor.
2. Entries are unlimited but each Exhibitor may only claim one prize per class.
3. The Judge's decision on merit is final and they reserve the right to withhold any prize and/or award in the event of lack of merit.
4. All unreserved exhibits or exhibits which are reserved but not removed at 4.30pm will be sold to raise money for the CAAGA allotment association.
5. Exhibitors should provide their own vases for those classes where vases are not provided but the Committee cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage thereto.
6. Any protest or objection made in writing will be considered by the Committee but their decision on this or any other matter pertaining to the Show shall be final.
7. Please don't remove exhibits before 4.30 pm.
8. Prizes not collected on the afternoon of the Show will be repaid into funds.

The making of an entry by an Exhibitor is deemed to be an acceptance of these rules.

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

OPEN TO ALL CLASSES (MEMBERS AND NON MEMBERS)

1. Arrangement of spring flowers – (flowers need not be home grown)
2. One jar of chilli jam
3. One jar of chutney
4. One jar of marmalade (indicate type on label)
5. One jar of fruit curd (indicate type on label)
6. Home-made bread, savoury
7. Home-made bread, sweet
8. Three decorated cupcakes
9. Three hot cross buns
10. A chocolate cake
11. 'A Celebration of Nature' – an original piece in any medium, e.g. painting, drawing, print, sculpture, freeform stitchcraft etc. **RESERVED FREE**
12. 'Springtime' a photograph not more than 5" x 7" – colour or black and white on the theme of spring.

CHILDRENS CLASSES (UP TO 16 YRS)

13. An Easter design of any medium on a paper plate
14. A small tub of home-grown cress
15. A Decorated hard-boiled egg
16. A Decorated Easter Bonnet

MEMBERS' FLOWER CLASSES

17. Bowl of spring flowering bulbs.

18. *B One vase of 3 cut narcissus. Long trumpets (i.e. trumpet longer than petals) One variety only, and one bloom per stem.
19. *B One vase of 3 cut narcissus. Medium or short trumpet or cup. One variety only one bloom per stem.
20. *B One vase of 3 cut narcissus. Three different varieties. One bloom per stem.
21. *B One vase of 3 cut narcissus – long or short trumpet, can be mixed varieties.
22. One vase of three miniature narcissus.
23. One vase of polyanthus.
24. One vase of cut heathers.
25. *B One vase of mixed spring flowers, **excluding** narcissus and polyanthus.
26. *B One vase of spring flowers of any one genus - **excluding** narcissus, polyanthus and hellebores.
27. *B One vase of tulips, single variety
28. *B One vase of hellebores.
29. Spray of flowering shrub
30. One cactus or succulent in a pot
31. One pot plant, foliage
32. One pot plant, flowering

MEMBERS' VEGETABLE CLASSES

33. Three spears of sprouting broccoli.
34. Three leeks, with roots trimmed to approx. 5 cm (2").
35. Three sticks of rhubarb.
36. Three sticks of forced rhubarb
